NOTE OF INTENT


The idea for this clip was to focus on the themes addressed in the text of the song - nature, pollution, uncertain future - to write an original story of a short film.

Drawn in a cartoon style, «Bare feet» take place in a society exploiting more and more natural ressources and humans. It also shows how the courage, coming from oneself to share all others, could overcome the problem.

The polluter tries to stop the march launched against his own interests, and finally runs away. The little girl, symbol of future, and the horizon covered with flowers, are opening the door of a doable hope, although tenuous.

As the song, from a pessimistic observation, the clip is therefore optimistic, suggesting that a less dark future is ahead of us, if we unit our consciences together to think a new world.

Born in 1977, Suki autoproduced short films in the late 90s combining his cinematic vision with his taste for drawing. Creator of « The Dick Spader investigations », selected at the Annecy and Ottawa festivals, Suki later creates an interactive comic for Nike, then in 2006, « Reflections », an animated thriller, with

international career: Dresden, Brooklyn, Animamundi...

In 2012, sponsored by the CNC and Pictanovo, « N'Djekoh » was selected for the Annecy festival in 2013 and was included in the program « The new faces of French animation », which toured Canada in 2014. In 2017, he co-founds, with Stéphane Debureau and Jean-Philippe Gréau, Utopi, an artistic cooperativ, with which he will direct and produce « The eel, the weasel and the vulture ». This animated fable will be selected in more fifty international festivals, as Cinanima and Zebra Poetry, will be added in the Extra Court catalog and will participate to the 2018 french short movie festival.



Born in 1972, the sound of the saxophone first leads him to the Conservatory, and later to the American School of Modern Music. Formed to be a stage actor (Picolo theatre, studio Alain de Bock), Stéphane then experimented different art forms (theatre, cinema, dubbing, etc.), and acted in the play « Black Out » in 2008. He has written one play directed by Stéphane Godin. He then joined the Cormorans company, founded by Maxime Lonnet and François Rousseau.

Since then he has been more and more drawn towardswriting. Stéphane published « Archipel » in 2012, with the Cosmogone Editions. A tale combining poetry, illustrations and music. In 2017,

he writes and composes with Jean-Philippe Gréau an EP titled « Evolution », produced both by Utopi, an artistic cooperativ co-founded with his two partners.

THE SONG « LES PIEDS NUS » (BARE FEET) COMES FROM THE 3rd ALBUM OF SUISSA, TITLED « ANIMAL SAVANT »



Suissa is a french-speaking composer, guitarist and singer in love with the wild, creative fever of the 70s. already two albums of engaging and sunny songs to the dancing rhythm of the islands of the Indian Ocean but also of Africa. bridges between pop and world music.

Curious about sounds, sensitive to words, exploring genres through the albums he composes or arranges for himself and others, Suissa is especially influenced by maloya and his encounters with Eno Zangoun (Danyel Waro, Tambour Crusaders), René Lacaille or David Doris who are leaders in the Reunion culture and men who give meaning to the word sharing.

Its musical spectrum extends from Ouaga to Hendrix, from Mada to Led Zeppelin, from Saint Leu to John Fante, from Louis Jean Cormier to Ussons in Forez... All these artists, these cultures, these places that give meaning to the text and the musicality.

After touring all over France, Switzerland and Reunion, Suissa prepares with all her team a third album « Animal Savant » directed by Olivier Soumali, the keyboard of Jain, and with many wonderful quests!
